# Easter Festival 2018 Street Parade Bourke Rotary Club

### **Safety Regulations**

- All participants are responsible for their own personal safety and security. Personal belongings must be in a secure place. All parade entrants should carry water and sun protection (sunscreen, hat & sunglasses).
- All vehicles must be roadworthy. Every care should be taken to ensure the safety of the public and any person travelling on or in the vehicle.
- Vehicles and floats must not exceed 4.0m height, 2.2m width. Non-complying vehicles shall be considered for entry on a case-by-case basis on application to the Parade Coordinator.
- Animals are subject to the parade terms and conditions listed below.
- The instructions of Traffic Controllers and the NSW Police must be obeyed at all times. Failure to comply with instructions by officials could result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future parades.
- The safety of each float or entry is paramount to all participants. Under no circumstances are thee to be any sharp or harmful object on or protruding from any structure or as part of any prop on the float. All participants should be fully versed and trained in the operation of any moving parts.
- In the interest of public safety, the Parade Organisers reserve the right to inspect each float or entry and, as a condition of participating in the parade, requiring any changes or modifications to the float which they deem necessary in the interests of safety.

#### Parade Terms & Conditions:

- All entries must continue in a forward motion through the parade route. Entries must not stop or cause delay. The instructions of the Traffic Controller Contractors and the NSW Police must be obeyed. Parade participants must adhere to the parade route and keep within parade time frames.
- Entries must proceed in the order designated by the Parade organiser.
- Alcohol is not to be consumed in the parade marshalling area or during the parade. Any person, deemed by any one or more of the Parade Organisers to be under the influence of alcohol or other licit or illicit substances, shall be excluded from participation in the parade.
- Children participating in the parade must be accompanied by adults at all times with no more than seven children to be in the charge of one adult.
- Photographs/film may be taken and used by the media and others to publicly promote Bourke and the Easter Festival and each participant waives any right to make any claim in relation thereto.
- Suitably experienced adults must accompany animals at all times and will be deemed responsible for the animal and crowd safety during the parade and marshalling. Entrants are responsible for collecting animal waste before, during and after the parade. Rotary and the Parade Coordinator reserve the right to assess the suitability for, and to refuse the involvement of any animal, on a case-by-case basis.
- Political propaganda must not be displayed, distributed or disseminated throughout the parade route.
- Entrants are not permitted to distribute or throw giveaways to the audience directly from their vehicle/float. Entrants may hand out giveaways from person to person, on foot, while on the parade route.
- No fireworks, crackers, sparklers or other pyrotechnics or sirens are to be used at any time during marshalling or the parade.
- Failure to comply with terms and conditions may result in removal from the parade and exclusion in future years.
- The participant acknowledges that he/she, in engaging in the parade: is not insured by the Rotary Club of Bourke, Rotary District 9670 and/or Rotary International ("Rotary") in respect of any loss, damage or injury; accepts that he/she carries his/her own risk of engaging in the parade; and indemnifies Rotary in respect of any and all claims for damages and/or costs made against Rotary in respect of any loss or injury to the participant, however arising.
